VISA EXEMPTION



Visitors from the following countries are eligible for a 14-day stay without a visa: Thailand, Brunei, and Myanmar.

Visitors from the following countries are eligible for a 30-day stay without a visa: Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Singapore, Philippines and Vietnam.





The Ministry of Foreign Affairs & International Cooperation has launched an e-visa, which enables most of the countries to apply for a Cambodia tourist visa online.

To apply for e-visa, applicants will need to prepare:

- ▣ Passport with a validity no less than six months
- ▣ One recent colour photo in digital format
- ▣ Visa fees apply and are subject to change without prior notice

After submitting the form online, you can check the status via this [link](#). The processing time will take around three business days.

The validity of e-visa approval letter is 90 days from the issue date. Length of stay is 30 days from the date of arrival in Cambodia. E-visa is only valid for a SINGLE ENTRY.

Not all borders of Cambodia accept e-visas, please check your port of entry before applying. Here are the Port of Entries which accept Cambodia e-visa:

- Phnom Penh International Airport
- Siem Reap International Airport
- Preah Sihanouk International Airport
- Cham Yeam (Koh Rong)
- Poipet (Banteay Meanchey)
- Bavet (Svay Rieng)
- Tropaeng Kreal Border Post (Stung Treng)

VISA-ON-ARRIVAL



Tourist visas can also be obtained upon arrival at the following Cambodia International Airports in:

- ▣ Phnom Penh
- ▣ Siem Reap
- ▣ Preah Sihanouk

However, please note that not all foreign passport holders can apply for visa-on-arrival. Please check with your Cambodia Embassy or Cambodia Consulate in your home country for specific visa requirements.

Not eligible for Visa-on-Arrival are passport holders from the following countries: Afghanistan, Algeria, Saudi Arabia, Bangladesh, Iran, Iraq, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Sudan and Nigeria. Visas must be arranged prior to entering the Kingdom of Cambodia.

To apply for visa on arrival, applicants will need to prepare:

- ▣ Passport with a validity no less than six months and blank pages for entry stamp
- ▣ Visa fees apply and are subject to change without prior notice



Visitors who are not eligible for e-visa or visa-on-arrival will need to apply for the visa in advance at the Cambodia Embassy or Cambodia Consulate in their home country. It can be either by mail or in person depending on the embassy or consulate.

If you apply by mail, please submit your application at least three weeks before your departure date.

To apply for visa in person, applicants will need to prepare:

- ▣ Passport with a validity no less than six months and blank pages for entry stamp.
- ▣ One recent 5cm x 5cm photo
- ▣ Visa fee
- ▣ A completed visa application
- ▣ Applicants may be requested to provide any other documents depending on their nationality
- ▣ A self-addressed prepaid return envelope (if apply via mail)

ARRIVALS

There are three international airports in Cambodia: Phnom Penh, Siem Reap, Silhanoukville.

In most gateway cities, you will be met by a Trails of Indochina representative wearing the Trails of Indochina uniform and carrying a Trails of Indochina signboard with your name on it.

In smaller cities or towns, you may be met by our regional partner who may not be wearing the Trails of Indochina uniform or have the signboard; however, a representative will still have your name printed on a clipboard in order for you to locate them easily.

It is important that you keep a copy of your completed immigration and customs form as you will need these to present at immigration upon departure from Cambodia.

VIP SERVICE

If you have booked our VIP Airport Arrival Service, an airport representative will meet you as you disembark the aircraft and take you to the VIP area for immigration formalities. During this time, a member of the airport staff will collect your luggage and then escort you to meet your tour guide.
